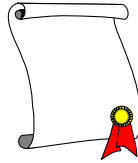

2. Medium: Any medium or mixed media may be used e.g. crayons, color pencils, watercolors, pastels, gel pens, tempera paints, Acrylic, oil paints.
3. On the back of the poster, glue or tape ALL registration information

5. **All entries must be received by April 3rd, 5pm 2008.**
6. Winners must be present to receive prizes and trophies on stage at the 14th Arizona Asian Festival's opening ceremony on Friday, April 18th, 2008 at Heritage Park.
7. All entries shall become the property of the Arizona Asian American Association. No entries will be returned.
8. One entry per person.
9. Judges' decisions are final.
10. Last year's winners are eligible to participate.
11. Winners or entries may be published within the AAAA Website, AAAA Newsletter, or any other publications.
